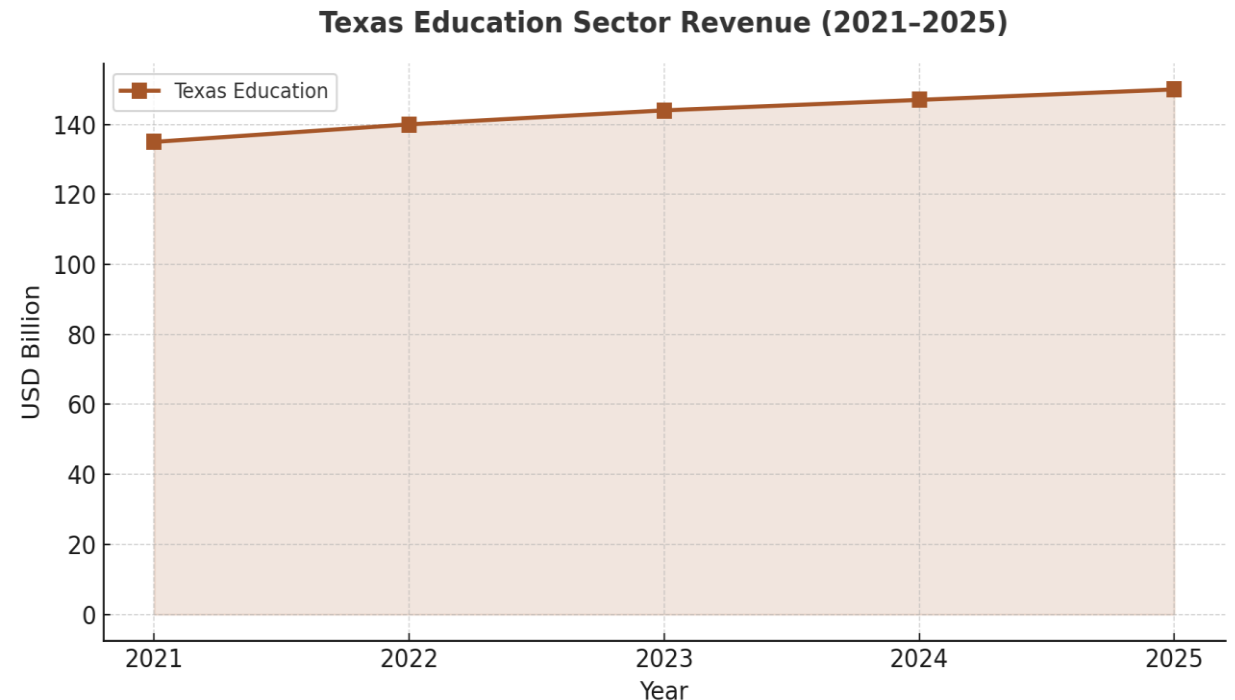
Economic Contributions and Employment
